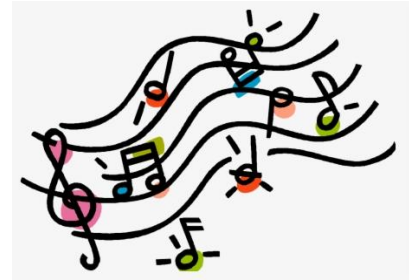


St. Mary's Parish School Music Program

Throughout the year students are learning and applying music basics such as:
