★ A wonderful tradition our school has had for over 45 years is a day at Klemgard Park. The park is between Pullman and Colfax and it has 59 acres of land that includes a trail, wide open spaces, an area of play equipment and a barbecue pit. Well-kept bathrooms, etc. It's just a space and place for the whole family. Given that it is outdoors and given the recent CDC guidelines, we are hoping as many parents who can will join us for the day of fun and sun. (There have only be two of the 45 years we've been rained out and had to make the

school into Klemgard!!!) Below is some key information for June 2nd. Please call if you have any questions. Given their age and length of day, we have found it best to have only students from Kindergarten through 8th Grade attend Klemgard and the Preschoolers and PreK will have their own "little" Klemgard at school.

IF you are planning on driving students (not just your own) to Klemgard please see the following information that was sent by Debbie to us recently. The requirements are from the Diocese.

Thank you so very much for volunteering to drive for the upcoming field trips and hopefully, Klemgard all-school picnic on June 2nd.

As a result of some of you completing your driving video requirements, the diocese has contacted me regarding some *additional* paperwork they do not have on file.

Fortunately some of the parents had previously completed some of the paper work because the documents are the same as in previous years. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: there have been several additions of which we had previously not been aware due to *COVID restrictions this year and not allowing volunteers in the school*. If you volunteering on driving students other than your own, review the following requirements and complete the necessary ones that will allow you to drive other children. Otherwise, *there are no requirements to drive your own child*.

School Volunteer and Driving Requirements:

1 - Catholic Mutual Group Training (Insurance Co.) - **cmgconnect.org** You will need to create an account and complete some training.

a - Please complete the **Driving Video** and print out the **Driving Certificate** and return it to the *school* with your paperwork. If you have already completed the driving video in a previous year, I should already have the certificate on file and you do not need to complete it again. If you are not sure, please print out another Driving Certificate and send it in to the school.

b - Please complete the **Safe Environment Training** video. Normally this is done inperson in a group setting, but there are no sessions planned for this time of year. There will be some sessions in the fall after school begins. If you have already taken this training, you must watch a renewal training on-line. If you have never taken the in-person Safe Environment training, then you must take it in the fall when it is given; this training lasts an hour and it is mandatory that everyone attends at least one in-person Safe Environment training. It is also mandatory that some training is completed every year; either the Safe Environment Training renewal or some other safety video on-line through the CMG website. It is for your safety and the safety of the children in your care. These trainings are on file with the diocese and constantly monitored for updates.

2 - Completion of the **Diocese of Boise Volunteer Acknowledgment Receipt** - The three policies on this receipt are available for reading and viewing on the Diocese of Boise website at: **catholicidaho.org** You can find them by clicking "offices" in the top menu bar, then go the HR section, and click on Safe Environment. Underneath the quoted paragraph to the right of the photo is the link to the three policies. Please read them and then complete the acknowledgement receipt and return it to the school with all the completed paperwork for final signatures.

3 - **Diocesan Background Check** - This is not an FBI fingerprinting background check. This is an internal diocesan background check. Please complete and return to the school.

4 - **Private Vehicle Driver Form** and **Private Vehicle Use Application** - Please complete and return to the school.

5 - Please provide a current copy of your insurance policy showing you meet the required insurance coverage if you are volunteering to drive students on field trips or to our annual picnic.

Again, if you would like to drive St. Mary's students, then these are all required and I must send them in to the Diocese next week for approval. The diocese is expecting these and will do a speedy process of approval in anticipation of our field trips and picnic our last week of school.

I also want to let you know that I have sent a packet home of the documents to be completed with one of your children. Please look for them.

We appreciate your willingness to volunteer and drive. We are looking forward to a quick turnaround of the completed documents. Should there be any questions, please feel free to call next week at 208-882-2121.

Some Questions

- Q. Will masks be required when the school (Kindergarten through 8th graders) go to Klemgard Park?
- A Since the students will be out in the fresh air on June 2^{nd} . masks will **not** be required.

Q. Will any of the procedures change before school is out on June 4th?

A. The changes have been made ONLY for those *who have been fully vaccinated*. Unvaccinated people, which at this point means children are still required to wear masks and practice social distancing. We, the teachers and staff who work with your child(ren) will continue to wear masks while working with them.

Q. Given the new guidelines from the CDC, are you going to allow the children to be outside without masks on?

A. According to CDC guidelines, children still need to wear a mask and continue to practice social distancing in order to be protected. It's important for the children to be in well ventilated spaces too (and as you know, our classrooms *are* well ventilated).

Q. How long will be children be required to wear masks?

A. For this school year, it is required through the last day of school, June 4th. Masks will not be required either at Klemgard (June 2) nor at the Mass on the Grass (Friday, June 4th) since we will be outdoors. However, any unvaccinated adults who are present must wear masks.

Q. For the school's Summer Program, will the children have to wear masks?

A. As a school, we must follow CDC guidelines for our young people. The school is in constant contact with Dr. Carol Moehrle, Director of District Health who provides us with the advice we need to follow for the safety and healthy of all the students who are not vaccinated.

Q. When will St. Mary's Church open up and be back to things as they were before the pandemic?

- **A.** The weekend of June 5/6 St. Mary's the following will happen:
 - The new Mass schedule will begin—no limit to numbers coming to Mass Saturday Mass is at 5:00 p.m. in Moscow Sunday Mass in Genesee at 7:30 a.m. Sunday Mass in Moscow both at 9:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.
 - 2) Communion will be offered under both species
 - 3) Face masks are no longer required. However, anyone who wishes to use them, they are free to do. IF someone needs social distancing, the front three rows are saved for them, as well as the choir loft. All ropes will be taken down beginning that weekend too.
 - 4) Liturgical ministries will begin to be fully operative again.
 - 5) Parish Center is fully opened.

We hope these responses addresses your questions. Do know, Fr. Joe or Sister Margaret are here to answer any others you may have. Thank you for both your understanding and support!
