Some questions we've been asked about school are the following

Q. Key question is the health provisions regarding school this fall are?

A. Given that the start of the new school year is still a month away (August 31) and given the recent rise in the virus cases in our area, etc. we will need to have the best information available in order to make the best decisions for the health, safety for our students and staff. We are keeping close contact with Carol Moehrle of North Central.

Q. Will there be an opportunity to have all families come together for a Back to School Night?

A. As it stands now: the answer is "yes". On Monday, August 30, our plan is to have a BBQ for all families provided by the School Board members. It is planned for 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. After the BBQ, the schedule is: 6:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. meeting with teachers of Grades PS through Grade 5 and then 7:00 to 7:30 p.m. meeting with teachers of Grades 6-8 upstairs in the wing off the gym.

Also, grades PS through Grade 5 will repeat their presentation to give the opportunity for all families with multiple children to meet with their children's teacher.

Q. When does school open?

- A. School opens the day after the BBQ---on Tuesday, August 31st. All students need to be on the ground on/by 8:00a.m. for school. (Childcare begins at 7:00 a.m.). When they come to school it will be necessary to have their temperature taken at the kiosk in the school.
- Q. Where do we buy the School Uniform? And what is required for the Uniform?
- A. Schoolbelles is our uniform company. *Attached* is the order form from Schoolbelles Company.
 Please connect with them to place your order.
- Q. May we buy the clothes required by the school for the uniform at local stores?
- A. As long as it is exactly the same, the answer is "yes". However, the school logo **IS** *required* on the student's shirt. Thank you!
- Q. Why are the families in Preschool through 8th Grade required to participate in the school's fundraisers?
- A. As a school, a key focus is to create viable ways of connecting the families in meaningful ways. As you may know the *actual* cost to education *every student* is \$7200. Tuition covers about 47% of the actual cost. Donations from the Foundation, St. Mary's Parish and individual donors assists with about 30% of the actual cost. The remaining amount comes from our **fun**draisers. And our focus here is not only on the money for the school budget, but actually on the **fun** part by bringing parents together so they get to know one another in a common project.
