Friday, Feb. 4: *Another favorite and long-standing tradition we have during Catholic Schools Week is **RAD and wear pajamas all day!***

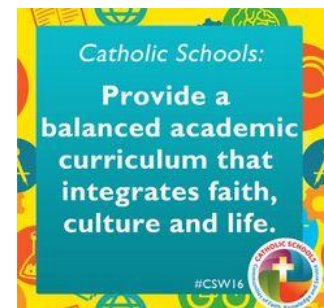
